

El *Presente* Perfecto

This is formed by using the *present* tense of the helping verb HABER and the *past participle*.

HABER
(“have”)

He Hemos

Has

Ha Han

PAST PARTICIPLE

AR- drop the AR and

*add: **ADO***

ER/IR-drop the ER

*Or IR and add: **IDO***

Irregular Past Participles:

Abrir (to open)=abierto

Cubrir (to cover)=cubierto

Descubrir(to discover)=descubierto

Escribir(to write) =escrito

Freír(to fry)=frito

Romper (to break)=roto

Ver (to see)=visto

Morir (to die)=muerto

Poner (to put, place , set)=puesto

Volver(to return)=vuelto

Decir(to say, tell)=dicho

Hacer to make, do)=hecho

Ejemplos:

Mi madre ha hecho la cena.=My mom has made dinner.

Yo he visto España.=I have seen Spain.

Ellos han ido a Francia.=They have gone to France.

*****Verbs that end in EER, AER, UIR and Oír
have an accent on the *Ído*...**
