

El Presente Perfecto

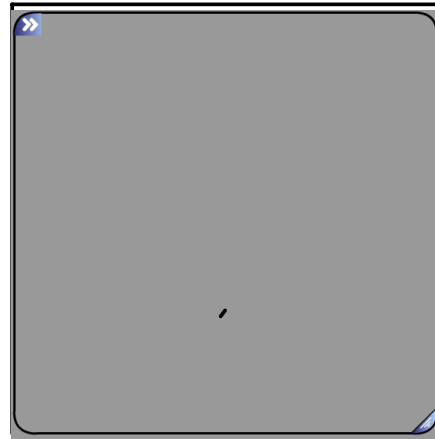
This is a "compound" tense that uses the helping verb HABER and a PAST PARTICIPLE

Haber (has, have)

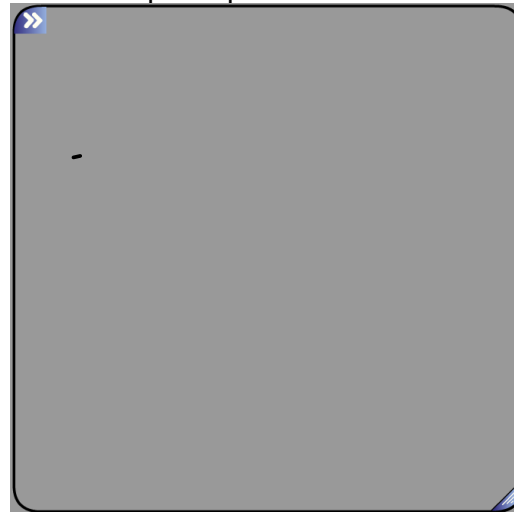
he-	hemos-

Past Participle ("ed/en" in Eng.)

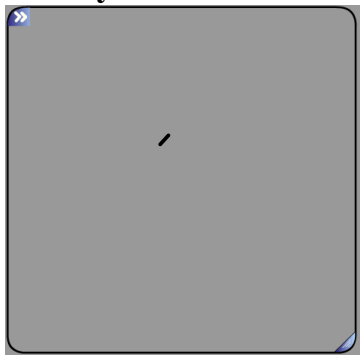
