- Remember that the verb "estar"

refers to location and condition.

ej: Mi padre está en Clinton.

- Use Ser for characteristics and qualities, jobs, associations, material of construction, origin, nationality, etc.

ejs: Yo soy de Colombia.  
Ellos son alumnos buenos.  
Nosotros somos mexicanos.

- The verb "IR" is often followed by the word "a".

ej: Yo voy a Madrid en junio.
