

#1. IR + a + INFINITIVE-expresses what will happen in the near future. This is frequently used in Spanish.

Ejemplos: *Mi hermano va a llegar a las ocho.= My brother is going to (will) arrive at 8:00.*

#2. FUTURE TENSE-expresses what "will" happen in the future.

FORMS: infinitive verb + endings

vivir

<u>hablaré</u>	<u>hablaremos</u>	<u>viviré</u>	<u>viviremos</u>

<u>hablará</u>	<u>hablarán</u>	<u>vivirá</u>	<u>vivirán</u>

Ejemplos: *Yo hablaré con Paco.=I will speak with Paco.*
Nosotros viviremos en París.=We will live in Paris.
