Ejemplos: Mi hermano es tan alto como yo.
(My brother is as tall as I am.)

Mis amigos son tan altos como yo.
(My friends are as tall as I am.)

Rule #2: Tanto...(noun)...como

tanto agrees with the noun after it and the verb agrees with the 1st subject

as much/as many.....as

Ejemplos: Yo tengo tanto dinero como tú.
(I have as much money as you.)

Yo sé tanto como tú. = I know as much as you.

Pedro tiene tantas revistas como ella.
(Pedro has as many magazines as her.)
